Ms. Verena Garafalo spoke with FootZone as the school dress code supplier for 2023-2024.

#### Principals' Report

- Welcome from Mr. Timpano
- Budget review
  - o Budget prepared by Ms. Sonia Marotta
  - All aligned with expectations including a deficit of \$82,201 impacting all elementary schools due to parents not being charged for Daycare services during COVID. This will slowly return to zero.
  - General note: when there are recurrent deficits, the principal works with the school commission finance department to alleviate losses.

#### Teachers' Report

- Kindergarten
  - o Parents have been coming in for mini career days to speak with the students
  - o Thank you to Home and School for the hot lunch
  - Kinderfest was a success
- Grade 1
  - Went to Inter-mieles for a day of activities
- Grade 5
  - Overnight camp at Debroulliards was a great success
- Grade 6
  - Graduate breakfast will take place this week at Vincent's on Robert
- School-wide
  - o Daycare tea organized by Ms. Daniella and Madame Marie-Josée was a great success
  - The end of year concert was great fun. We have not had time to count the money raised, but appears to be a little over \$700
  - o Fun in the Sun was great
  - Energy Cubes: We collected 61,000, a new record and surpassed the original target of 10,000

- Started with carry-over from previous years, amounting to \$889. Expenses for catering and light snacks came to ~\$695, so we are left with \$193 that will carry over to next year.

#### Central Parents Committee Report

#### Merika Ramundo reported:

- Letter drafted and submitted from EMSB Parents Committee to EMSB senior administration calling for immediate action to develop a plan around mental health initiatives to be implemented across the school board.
- Misinformation at schools around uniforms. Where there is a dress code (like in Honoré Mercier's case), the school can provide a digital version of the crest to be used by the parent to place on uniforms. The school also cannot impose a supplier or a brand of clothing on parents. The school may require, for example, a white polo shirt and navy blue pants or skirt, but parents are free to get them where they want.
- PC Parent Commissioners brought forward a letter against the banning of raffles, bingos, 50/50
  draws along with a motion. The motion to reinstate the above fundraising activities was passed as
  long as Home and Schools and PPOs follow the regulations laid out by the QC government and
  guidelines set out by EMSB and principals. More information to come.
- 2023-2024 will be a key year for EMSB schools and their communities. A board wide review of all
  educational projects will take place. Governing Board members and constituents will play a key role
  in this process. More information to come.

- Motioned to have Next Level Hockey return with an updated curriculum focused on training instead of competition, which was agreed to by NLH
- May
  - Motioned to have GB Chair reach out to senior EMSB admin to attend the June GB meeting to address a number of questions concerning enrollment. She could not attend and referred back to the school admin.
  - Motioned to allow Home and School to order chocolates now for the 2023-24 chocolate fundraiser allowing us to achieve better margins. This was done.

#### Question Period/Varia

- What happens if in September we suddenly have 25 kids in Pre-K? Will we be stuck with one class?
  - o No, the admin will have until about October 15 to adjust the number of registrations.
- There are other schools that do have school supply ordering programs. Why are they allowed, and we are not?
  - No public school is allowed to do this, the ones that do just haven't been reprimanded yet.
- Is there an update on split classes?
  - Split classes are not a governing board topic.
