- Mask Wearing / Composition
  - Before the news came out that public health mentioned a possible toxic procedural mask, some CPC parents were concerned about the mask, manufacturing process and PPM output.
  - Post the news, many parents showed their frustration and have demanded the EMSB to provide the Data Sheets that are supposed to come with masks. I and a few parents mentioned even though the datasheet may be safe, we should be conducting our own tests via an independent laboratory and use the CPC funds to conduct them if necessary.
- Rapid-Covid Testing
  - With the Variant Covid Virus on the rise, some parents were wondering if the EMSB had any communication with the Governments about the Rapid Saliva tests that are currently in storage in Quebec warehouse to be used/deployed in schools in Hot zones.
- 2021-2022 Holiday Calendar
  - EMSB provided a proposed a holiday/Ped Day for the following year, some parents had suggested alternate solutions.

**Presentation by Enzo Caprio,** Director of Clinical Laboratories at OPTILAB, McGill University Health Center Cluster, and **Aileen Montesclavos,** Clinical Nurse (Cardiology), MUHC

- Key factors in reducing the risk of COVID-19
  - COVID-19 is 100% airborne and proper ventilation is extremely important
    - Other school boards have been much more proactive regarding ventilation systems in their schools
  - Many activities can magnify the spread of COVID-19
    - These activities include running, signing, skipping, etc...
  - Wearing is mask is key, but its important to remember that the eyes are transmission points as well
- Similar to the flu, there is a higher spread of COVID-19 in the winter
- Hospitalizations
  - First wave mainly 70 years old + were hospitalized
  - Second wave about 70% are under the age of 40 years old
- Long-term effects
  - CT Scans on people who have recovered from COVID-19 show enlargement of the heart muscle.
  - Heart condition may likely be a long-term effect of COVID-19; however, it will take 3-5 years to fully understand the effects.
- Testing
  - Recommendation is to wait 7 days after you have been in contact with/start to experience symptoms of COVID-19 to be tested
  - The way a test in performed may have an impact on the result
- Impact on Honoré Mercier
  - HM was one of the last schools to report a positive COVID-19 test
  - The administration really did a great job of preparing the school for the new reality and keeping the students safe.
    - The issue is with how the HM community behaves outside of the school and what is subsequently brought into the school.
