ST. Patrick's Day



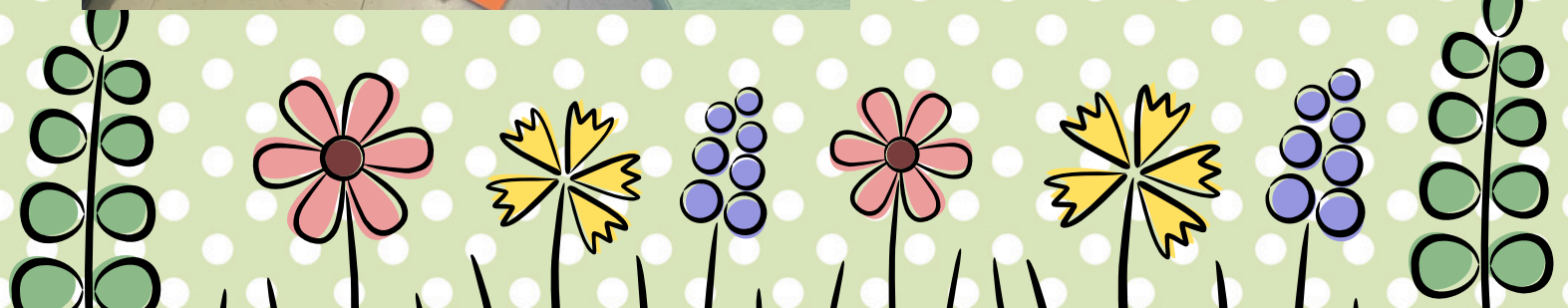
